## 4 ways to improve your searches

1. Boolean

Works in most search engines and databases

**AND** eg. apples AND oranges

Narrows a search (You don't need to add AND in Google) **OR** eg. apples OR oranges

Widens a search (Needs to be in CAPS)

NOT

eg. apples NOT oranges

Narrows a search (In Google, use a minus sign in front of the word, eg. apples -oranges)

## 2. Quotes

Works in most search engines and databases

To search for those exact words in that exact order put them in speech marks.

eg. "fruit salad"

## 3. Search a filetype

Only in Google, Sweetsearch etc

To search in Google for a particular type of document, eg. pdf, ppt

Enter your keywords followed by filetype:...

eg. fruit health benefits filetype:pdf

## 4. Search a url

Only in Google, Sweetsearch etc

To limit your search to a particular type of website, eg. .edu, .gov, .au.

To use Google to search within a particular website, eg. the ABS.

Enter your keywords followed by site:...

eg. apple farming site:abs.gov.au

growing oranges site:.au
